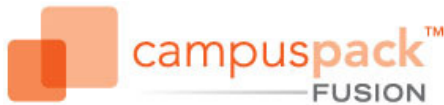




Objectives:

- Subscribe using Google Reader
- Subscribe using Juice



Quick Start Guide: Subscribing to a Podcast

Podcast episodes can be played directly from the course page; however, users can subscribe to the podcast. The content media is then sent directly to the subscriber's podcatcher (e.g., iTunes or Juice) or by some other feed aggregator (e.g., Google Reader or Netvibes).

Note: The sharing permissions for the podcast site must be made available to everyone to enable the RSS functionality.


1. Enter a podcast site.

Steps:



Subscribing Using iTunes

1. Select .
2. On the **Launch application** dialog button, select **iTunes** as the application.
3. Click the **OK** button.

Subscribing Using Google Reader

1. Right click .
- If you are using a Macintosh, press the **ctrl** key on your keyboard and click the **RSS** button at the same time.
- If using Firefox as your browser, select the **Copy Link Location** option.
- If using Internet Explorer as your browser, select the **Copy Shortcut** option.
2. Launch the Google Reader application.
3. Click  or the **Add Subscription** link.
4. In the subscription address field, right click and select the **Paste** option.
5. Click  (**Add** button).

Subscribing Using Juice

1. Right click .
2. Launch the Juice application.
3. On the **Subscriptions** tab, click  (**Add new feed**).
4. In the **Add a Feed** dialog box, right click and select the **Paste** option in the **URL** field.
5. Click the **Save** button.
